

Tamale / Salsa Info

November 5-6, 2018

1. November 5th – Salsa Delivery – 3:00pm in the Brazoswood Choir Room.

- a. Enter through open door.
- b. Pick up order form and tally sheet. (We will give you a xerox of your order form)
- c. Wait for the guide person to take you to an available table. Walk to the table.
- d. Give form to student helper.
- e. They will place the order on the table for you to verify. Do not pack until verified.
- f. Pack the quart “glass jars” for travel.
- g. Bring boxes, ice chests, newspaper.
- h. Glass jars break. Quart jars are heavy.
- i. Sign for your order and depart room through exit doors
- j. **ALERT:** You must plan for transportation and let your customers know you are coming.
- k. **Suggestion:** Some people pick up Salsa Monday but wait until Tuesday to deliver both Salsa and Tamales at the same time.
- l. We would like to done by 4:30pm. We will start calling you as we approach deadline.

2. November 6th – Tamale Delivery – 3:00pm in the Brazoswood Choir Room.

- a. **ALERT:** Tamales will be delivered hot and fresh. That means they need to stay hot and fresh or get frozen after they cool.
- b. The Tamales are grouped in dozens in clear zip lock bags.
- c. **WARNING:** The bags contain a magic marker stripe/label that tells the flavor. They all look the same. The colors fade due to heat and oil. Check carefully what you are delivering or your order will be a mess.
- d. Enter the same door as before.
- e. Get your tally sheet and order form (You will get the original yellow form back)
- f. Wait for the guide person to take you to an available table. Walk to the table.
- g. Give the order form to the student helper.
- h. They will put the order on the table and group it in plastic bags by flavor.
- i. Be absolutely sure that you are getting the correct items. Do not pack until verified.
- j. **ALERT:** Count with them and help double check accuracy and labeling.
- k. Be calm and give them a chance. Every order has to be pulled from six sources.
- l. Pack your items for travel. Nobody wants crushed tamales.
- m. **SUGGESTION:** Bring an ice chest to keep things hot.
- n. **WARNING:** Do not let hot food get off temperature. You will make people sick. Deliver it hot or let it cool down and then freeze them solid until delivered.
- o. We would like to be done before 4:30pm. Do not be late!
- p. **INFO:** You are welcome to bring your ice chest in the morning. Label with your name.

Bean Regular - Black Marks On Bag
Bean Spicy - Black and Red Marks On Bag
